

INVITATION TO BID

The Township of Salisbury will receive sealed bids for the Flexer Avenue Roadway Improvements Project including ADA curb ramps, full depth pavement reclamation with chemical addition, superpave material, and pavement markings along approximately 1800 linear feet of Flexer Avenue. Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 PM (prevailing time) on Monday, July 12, 2010 at the office of Keystone Consulting Engineers, Inc., 6235 Hamilton Boulevard, Wescosville, PA 18106-9797. Bids will be opened on Tuesday, July 13, 2010, at 2:00 PM at the Township of Salisbury Municipal Building, 3000 South Pike Avenue, Allentown, PA 18103, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Copies of the Drawings and Specifications / Bid Forms will be available at Keystone Consulting Engineers, Inc., 6235 Hamilton Boulevard, Wescosville, PA 18106, upon request and deposit of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per set. The full amount of the deposit for one set of documents will be refunded to a bona fide bidder who returns the documents in good condition within ten (10) days after the date of the bid opening.

Each bid must be accompanied by Bid Security made payable to the Township of Salisbury in an amount of ten percent (10%) of the Bid price and in the form of a certified or bank check or a Bid Bond issued by a surety meeting the requirements of Paragraph 5.01 of the General Conditions. The successful bidder must furnish Performance and Payment Bonds each in the amount equal to the Contract Price and meeting the requirements of Paragraph 5.01 of the General Conditions.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 at 10:00 AM in the Township building.

Minimum wage rates in accordance with the Pennsylvania Wage Act, as amended, shall be paid to all working employees on this project.

The Township of Salisbury reserves the right to waive any informality in, and to reject, any or all bids.
