Pool Fill Policy

If you are looking to have your pool filled in Salisbury Township, the Fire Departments can help! Below you will find the process to have your pool filled.

- 1) Determine how much water you need. The following link can help you estimate the amount of water you need: <http://www.aquaduckwater.com/how-much-water-do-i-need/>
- 2) Call Salisbury Township at (610) 797-4000, to purchase the water. Make sure to retain your receipt of purchase or the fire department will not be able to fill your pool.
- 3) Once you have a receipt of water purchase, contact your local fire department:
For Eastern Salisbury residents: (610) 797-5227
For Western Salisbury residents: (610) 972-8978

Please leave your name, address, and phone number as a message if we can't answer the phone.

- 4) A member of the fire department will return your call to setup the fill date. Please allow 2 weeks for a fill date, and complete the attached waiver before the fill.
- 5) On the day of your fill:
 - Please have your pool open, clean, and ready to fill.
 - Please have all pets secured inside. The fire department will not enter if there is an unsecured pet.
 - Please have your water purchase receipt on hand. If you do not have a receipt of water purchase from Salisbury Township, the fire department will not fill your pool.
 - Please have a clear path to run the hose to your pool. We will do our best not to cause any damage, but fire hose is heavy and can damage plants and fences. The fire department is not responsible for any damage that occurs to your property or pool during the fill.
 - A \$100 donation to the fire department is suggested per 10,000 gallons. These funds go directly to the volunteer fire department. Please do not give cash or tips to the firefighters, but rather a check made out to your local fire company.
 - Feel free to watch, help, and get to know your local firefighters fill your pool.
 - Please remember that the fire departments are all volunteer, protecting our Township 24/7. Thus, it may be necessary to pause or reschedule your fill if there is an emergency.



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Pool Fill Release and Indemnity Agreement

Intending to be legally bound, and in further consideration of the use of the Fire Company equipment, the undersigned agrees as follows:

1. We release any claims on behalf of ourselves or members of our family which may arise as a result of using the Fire Company's equipment for the hauling of water to our premises, whether any claims arise from the negligence or neglect of the Fire Company personnel or others and whether or not said claims relate to property damage or personal injury.
2. We agree to hold the Fire Company and Salisbury Township harmless and to indemnify it from the claims of any third parties which may arise out of the use of said water for any purpose, or arise out of spillage, leakage, potability, personal injury to others, or otherwise.
3. There will be a \$25 fee for all returned checks.
