

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2016-603

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SALISBURY, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 201.1 OF CHAPTER 15, PART 2, "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ESTABLISH MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON FAIRVIEW ROAD WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and review, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interests of the Township community to establish speed limitations on certain roadways within Salisbury Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Salisbury, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the same that Section 201.1 of Chapter 15, Part 2 of the Code of Ordinances, shall be amended as follows, to wit:

ARTICLE I. Section 201.1 of Chapter 15, Part 2 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to include the speed limit restrictions on the roadway listed below and speed limit signs shall be installed along such roadway accordingly.


<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Fairview Road	East Emmaus Ave. & Susquehanna St.	35 mph

ARTICLE II. ENACTMENT



It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
