

AUTO REPAIRS ON RESIDENTIAL LOTS

Vehicle Repairs. No residential lot of less than one acre in a residential district shall be used outside of an enclosed building for the following work upon a motor vehicle or a recreational vehicle that is not currently registered to a permanent resident of such lot if such work:

- (a) Involves spray-painting.
- (b) Involves structural body or frame work.
- (c) Involves substantial disassembly of a transmission.
- (d) Is perceptible from a lot line of a dwelling between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.
- (e) Involves the payment of compensation for work, other than for actual expenses.
