What is included in the program?

- Hazardous Waste
 - Oil Based Paints (No Latex)
 - Paint Thinners – Solvents
 - Petroleum based lubricants
 - Pesticides, Herbicides
 - Aerosols
 - Cleaners – Acidic & Basic
 - Resins and Epoxy
 - Pool Chemicals
 - Light Bulbs
 - Batteries
- Collection Limits per pick-up
 - 2 gallons of liquid
 - 2 pounds of Solids
 - 1 Automotive Battery



What is included in the program?

- Electronic Waste (eWaste)
 - Televisions (TV)
 - Computer Monitors
 - Computers
 - VCR and DVD players
 - Printers
 - Fax Machines
 - Cable boxes
 - Gaming equipment
 - Other Similar devices
- Collection Limits per pick-up
 - 2 item limit per collection



What is NOT included in the program?

- Latex Paint
- Motor Oil and Coolant
- Ammunition/Explosives
- Unknown/Unlabeled materials
- Radioactive Compounds
- Smoke Detectors
- Tires
- Asbestos
- PCB (Polychlorinated biphenyls)
- Pharmaceuticals/Controlled Substances (medicines)
- Medical Sharps
- Biological/Infectious Wastes
- Fire Extinguishers
- E-Cigarettes



Requesting a pick-up

- Resident calls in HHW/eWaste pick-up Request
- Customer service will confirm the following
 - Residents Name & Address
 - Inventory of materials to ship
 - Date of next HHW/eWaste pick-up.
- Customer service will ship out a poly bag to the resident to be used to place HHW materials in on the day of shipment.
 - HHW materials are required by the state to be in specific poly bags.
 - eWaste materials are not required to be in poly bags



Day of Pick-up

- Homeowner is to place the bag and its contents along with any eWaste material outside the front entrance of the household.
 - Materials for pick up must be placed on the homeowner's property, they cannot be placed on the curb along with the MSW and Recycling.
 - Pick-ups may start as early as 6AM on the scheduled day of service.
 - Materials must be visible from the street.
 - Must be outside any fenced or gated areas.
 - Homeowners do not need to be home for the pick-up.
 - Any unacceptable quantities or unacceptable materials will be left.
